## WHAT TYPE OF SCHOOL IS HORIZON HIGH SCHOOL?

Horizon is a private, non-profit recovery high school that meets the needs of students and their families who are seeking a safe, drug-free and supportive environment in which to learn and stay sober.

This small therapeutic structure provides aftercare and relapse prevention and compliments each student's individual efforts in outside counseling and/or support programs.

## EDUCATION AT HORIZON

Horizon High School offers an integrated curriculum that prepares students for post high school education as well as the job world. Curriculum development is guided by and meets all Wisconsin state educational standards.

Education at Horizon includes traditional classroom instruction in the core disciplines, life skills education, physical wellness, hands-on learning and group discussion – all with an emphasis on encouraging participation and understanding.

*Founded in 2005, Horizon High School was started by Madison-area parents looking for a safe, sober and supportive place for their recovering teens to go to high school.*

## HORIZON HIGH SCHOOL PROVIDES:

- Daily group counseling with a certified AODA counselor
- Personal relapse prevention and recovery plans
- Individualized learning
- Random weekly drug testing
- Life skills education
- Hands-on learning
- A safe, sober and supportive environment to learn in

## SCHOOL YEAR AND CALENDAR

Horizon High School has NO residency restrictions and enrolls students at any time throughout the school year. Students can begin earning credits as soon as they enroll. This allows students who may be credit-deficient to begin to catch up and get back on track toward graduation.

Most interested students spend 1 -2 days shadowing at Horizon High School before official enrollment.

School meets Monday – Friday 8:30am to 2:30pm and follows the MMSD school calendar for breaks and holidays.

Each week at HHS integrates traditional classroom learning, hands-on life skills education and AODA counseling.

## ADMISSIONS

### EACH STUDENT MUST:

Want to attend Horizon High School

Complete a screening process & pay a \$100 application fee

Have 30 days of sobriety and have successfully completed a recovery program and/or be in counseling

## TUITION & FINANCIAL AID

MMSD students may transfer to Horizon and receive tuition assistance from the district. MMSD families are responsible for additional school supply and transportation fees

Students from other districts may also be eligible for tuition assistance. HHS will work with you to explore tuition assistance options

Tuition = \$6,000 per semester
